

GASRPC County Range – Sneedhams Green Covid-Specific Range Orders

- **Use of the range is by club booking only** until at least the end of August 2020 when these range orders will be reviewed
 - Each Club must conduct a Risk Assessment of Sneedhams Green range taking into account the profiles of its own members.
 - A Club Official pre-books the range via email to sgoodwin@houndscroft.co.uk and confirmation goes on-line. Current bookings can be viewed at <https://www.gasrpc.uk/county-range/view-range-bookings>
 - **No less than two and no more than six shooters** including the RO are present at any one time.
 - Specific range times are booked which will be 09.00 to 12.00; 13.00 to 16.00; 17.00 to 20.00. Participants are reminded only to turn up at the specified time and not to turn up early for their sessions. This procedure is necessary to allow the safe entry and exit of club members to the range.
 - Designated Club RO to raise/lower flag and set out/recover targets after each session.
 - Designated Club RO to ensure individuals keep personal shooting record from the session.
 - Even if low numbers of members are using the range, then one member must be designated as the supervising RO to undertake all applicable safety duties whilst on the range. This duty can be shared between and at the discretion of the members participating.
 - Should a pre-booked club session only have one club member in attendance due to unforeseen circumstances and that attendee has their own applicable shooting insurance, then that member will be permitted to shoot as a solo participant for the duration of that pre-booked club session.
- Sensible precautions and conditions for each session are to include:
 - Club and/or members to provide own hand sanitiser/targets/pins. There will be no access to the range box or range log.
 - No sharing of rifles or equipment, no guests, no Exemption Certificate rifles.
 - Full Club Members only as close proximity supervision and coaching is not permitted.
 - All used targets and shot brass to be cleared up and taken home for disposal.
 - All used firing point tables and any used bench-rest tables to be sanitised after use.
- Entry, Exit, Lane Control and Facilities at the site:
 - No car sharing unless from same household.
 - Upper and lower car parks will be in use with sufficient space for social distancing on arrival.
 - The gated firing point entry will be locked back.
 - Only five socially distanced designated firing points will be open plus one for the RO.
 - There will be no toilet facilities open, but hand sanitiser **may** be available for those who forget.
- **All existing Sneedhams Green Range Orders remain in place**
